

Craig's Column

The season of Advent marks the beginning of a new church year. It is intended to offer a time to reflect once again on the meaning of the incarnation, ministry, suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus for us. In the season of Advent we focus on the threefold coming of Jesus Christ to the world in the flesh, in the Word and the Sacraments, and in glory. At this time each year we in the church should ask ourselves "Why would the Lord of all the universe care enough about us mortals to take our flesh and share our woes?"

The answer to this question lies in the heart of Christmas. Jesus came as God with us, not only in physical form but also through his Word and Sacraments. He is Immanuel, "God with us" (Matt 1:23). By taking on our human nature he identified himself fully with our joys and sorrows, setting an example for us to follow. His coming into the world was a sign that we are loved unconditionally by God – no matter who or where we are – and that there is hope even when all seems lost or hopeless.

At Christmas time we remember how much Jesus loves each one of us; how he entered history so as to redeem it from sin; how he sacrificed himself out of love for humanity; how his death on the cross opened up a way back home for those who have gone astray. We celebrate Christ's birth because it marks an opportunity given to each one of us: allowing access into relationship with God which leads ultimately towards eternal life if followed faithfully through repentance, faithfulness and obedience. The Advent season prepares believers spiritually by reminding

them that they must be constantly ready because nothing can separate them from their Lord's love (Rom 8:39).

Since the season of Advent occurs during the four weeks prior to Christmas Day, it can be easy for us to focus our eyes only on the baby Jesus cradled in the manger. But if we pull back the curtains a little farther we can bring into view all the ways that God comes to us. We can remember that the Lord of all creation loves us enough to come and dwell with us, at Christmas and every day.

During the season of Advent we can remember that God comes to us in a variety of ways: through relationships, nature, music and art. He also comes to us in our everyday moments - when we are filled with joy or sorrow; when we experience restlessness or peace; when life is overwhelming and chaotic or calm and quiet. We can find Him in the midst of it all because He is always present.

Advent reminds us that no matter where our journey takes us, God will be there waiting for us with open arms ready to offer comfort, guidance and love along every step of the way. This season let's take time to pause from all the hustle-and-bustle around Christmas preparations so that we may really focus on how God continues coming into our lives in a fresh way, each day and everyday!



OPEN: Mondays, Thursdays, Fridays 10am - 3pm Saturdays 10am - 2pm


